Courts have started implementing the T-CAP program (Targeted Community Alternative to Prison) in Montgomery County. F-5 felonies (and below) are the target for T-CAP. These include possession of under a gram of heroin, breaking and entering, non violent and non sexual felonies. Courts can give local time in jail, but not prison.
